My name is ----- (City, State) -----, I am calling/writing about the second arrest of Mrs. Victoire Ingabire Umuhoza in Rwanda, this Thursday, October 14, 2010.

Since April this year, Mrs. Victoire Ingabire Umuhoza, leader of the main Rwandan political party, the FDU-Inkingi, was living under house arrest within Kigali City.

After a week of siege without any explanation whatsoever, the Rwandan police has just drifted into the house and arrested her.

She was taken immediately to the headquarters of the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) for unknown reasons.

This arrest comes amid a climate of heavy political tension marked by wanton attacks against the democratic opposition

I am asking to ask you to demand her immediate release from Rwandan jail. Her arbitrary detention violates her human rights.

She is in danger and deserves the highest level of advocacy from any human rights organizations, media outlets and your government.

Please call for his immediate release.
